THE PRESIDENCY IN NUMBERS

- 4 formal and informal meetings of Heads of State and Government
- 46 Council meetings
- Approximately 1780 meetings in Brussels in total during DK Presidency
- DK Ministers in the European Parliament 85 times
- 8 informal ministerial meetings in Denmark
- Hundreds of conferences and events arranged in relation to the Presidency

FRAMEWORK CONDITIONS FOR THE PRESIDENCY

Taking over Presidency in times of crisis:

- Europe facing major challenges due to economic crisis (dominating agenda of Danish Presidency)
- ➤ Cooperation in a crisis (European Council on 9 December 2011 agreeing on content of Fiscal Compact UK and Czech Republic not participating)
- Possible break-up of cooperation into several fractions?



THE BRIDGE OVER TROUBLED WATERS

Ambition of the Presidency: 1) Acting as a bridge over troubled water and 2) demonstrating that cooperation works and able to create results





RESULTS: A RESPONSIBLE EUROPE

- <u>European Semester</u>
- Strengthened economic cooperation in the euro countries ("two-pack")
- <u>Financial regulation</u>
 - Derivatives trading
 - > Strengthened capital requirements
 - Credit rating agencies
 - Negotiating box on the MFF (including Horizon 2020, Cohesion Policy, etc.)



AUSTERITY VS. GROWTH-MEASURES? NOT AN EITHER OR, BUT COMBINATION OF BOTH





RESULTS: A DYNAMIC EUROPE

- A European Compact on Growth and Jobs, agreement on EU Patent Reform
- Reform of the Single Market
- Roaming III
- Pilot phase of European project bonds
- Guidelines on transportation TEN-T
- Free Trade Agreements (FTAs)



RESULTS: A GREEN EUROPE

- The Energy Efficiency Directive
- Sulphur from marine fuels
- Rio+20
- A seventh EAP, Seveso III, export of Dangerous Chemicals
- Fisheries (ban on discard and guidelines for third country agreements)



RESULTS: A SAFE EUROPE

- Candidate status to Serbia, agreement to open accession negotiations with <u>Montenegro</u>
- A European "Passenger Name Record" (PNR) system
- JHA files, e.g. minimum Standards on the rights, support and protection of victims of crime
- Schengen package
- <u>Asylum package</u>



COMMUNICATIONS AND LOGISTICS

Key facts:

- 160 meetings in DK (informal ministerials, conferences, seminars, etc.)
- 10,268 delegates have participated
- The eight informal ministerial meetings and the visits by the Commission and the European Parliament to Denmark were covered by 750 journalists
- 35,222 presidency neckties and scarves have been produced to use for gifts to guests and other stakeholders in Denmark and around Europe
- A total of 87,000 notepads and 77,000 pens with the Presidency logo have been produced - all in a sustainable manner
- News on eu2012.dk: More than 240 press releases, 40 insight articles and 31 background articles more than 700.000 visits. The Presidency has tweeted more than 1,300 times, more than 6,000 followers
